According to folklore, Serbia's National Drink Slivovitz (Plum Brandy) originates from a recipe the Monks at the monastery of St. Prokupia in Prokuplje, Southern Serbia, developed in the XIV century. Over the centuries the recipe hasn't changed, but the process has been refined and perfected to produce a smooth and well-balanced nectar. Aged for 10 years in oak barrels to mellow and achieve depth of character, this Slivovitz is ideally served neat amongst friends and family. Say a prayer for the ingenious Monks as you enjoy it!



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
