as 1648, the winery has been in Kobern since 1892. Oenologist Konrad Hähn now continues this tradition and has achieved 2 national awards for excellence, is recommended every year by Feinschmecker Magazine

and was among the Top 100 estates in 2004.

He grows mainly Riesling and a small percentage of Pinot Noir. The terroir is slate soil and all vines are

planted on steep terraced slopes only.

Tasting note: There's an austerity about this kabinett, though it's

elegant and well-integrated. Peach, nectarine and grapefruit flavors hold court with a lining of mineral,

followed by a nice salty aftertaste.

Drink now through 2022.
